

Your Open Access Options

Gold route:

Choose the gold route if you want to publish the article in a journal which makes the full text freely available to readers immediately after publication.

Green route:

Choose the green route if you want to deposit a copy of the full text in an open access repository.

Determine your eligibility for our open access reimbursement scheme

Did the project end within the last 24 months?



Is the paper an original primary research article directly relating to a grant funded by Prostate Cancer UK?

Only grants which are still active or ended within the previous 24 months are eligible.



Has the paper been accepted for publication in a recognised journal? Recognised journals are listed on PubMed: https://ftp.ncbi.nih.gov/pubmed/J_Medline.txt

You will need to speak to your research funder and identify their open access policy.



Is the journal fully open access?

Please choose a journal from the PubMed journal list: https://ftp.ncbi.nih.gov/pubmed/J_Medline.txt



Is the research funded by multiple funders?

Does the journal have an open access option?



Have Prostate Cancer UK been acknowledged in the manuscript?

Where multiple funders are acknowledged, please ensure that the publication fees are evenly shared between the relevant parties.



Has the acknowledgement been checked in the manuscript by Prostate Cancer UK?

In all outputs arising from Prostate Cancer UK funded work researchers must acknowledge our financial support. The requested format can be found in our guidance.



Has the paper been licenced using a Creative Commons Attribution licence (CC-BY)?

Send your manuscript to us before it is published, so we can confirm the acknowledgement of funding is correct.



You can submit your application to the Prostate Cancer UK open access reimbursement scheme.

We will only reimburse article processing charges if the authors and publishers have licensed papers using a Creative Commons Attribution licence (CC-BY). This means that the research papers can be reused, shared and copies can be made, whilst also making sure the author is attributed.

Does your chosen journal have an embargo period of less than 6 months?



Deposit the article in an open access repository, for example an institutional repository.

You have two options:
Option 1: Consider submitting the article to a different journal that has a shorter embargo period.

Option 2: Consider publishing via the gold route by choosing a journal which is fully open access or one that has an open access option.

We can help to cover the costs of **Gold Route** open access through our open access reimbursement scheme.

I have been funded by Prostate Cancer UK but the output is not primary research. It is a review article, editorial, monograph or book chapter.

Unfortunately we can only cover the open access costs for primary research articles.

You have two options:
Option 1: Consider publishing via the **Green Route**

Option 2: Consider publishing in another journal which is fully open access or has an open access option.
