


Maintaining the Information Point



About the Patient Information Points

The Patient Information Points come in two designs – a free-standing floor stand or a wall-mounted stand so you can choose the one best suited for your department.

Floor Stand:

650 mm wide x 500 mm deep x 1200 mm high

Number of pockets: 12 x A5

(also takes A4)

With detachable wheels

Wall Stand:

800 mm wide x 40 mm deep x 1200 mm high

Number of pockets: 12 x A5



Each Information Point comes with an accompanying pack of our most popular titles, this includes:

- **Pre diagnosis** – information for men who have not yet been diagnosed with prostate cancer including information on signs and symptoms.
- **Prostate cancer** – including information on living with prostate cancer and supporting someone with prostate cancer.
- **Treatment** – leaflets on treatment options including hormone therapy, common side effects including emotional, and sexual side effects and information on available support.
- **General information** – including full lists of the other publications we provide and services we offer to support men and their families.
